Psalm refrain: The Lord is near to all who call on him.

INTRODUCTION TO THE MASS

Isaiah advises us to seek the Lord, an activity we might think of as being complete as soon as we come to believe in him. But really, this is an invitation to grace – a grace that is constant, always available, and generous in its forgiveness. It is a promise of deep and perpetual care by a God who is completely different from us in his thoughts and ways, and whose love and mercy never end.

LITURGY OF THE WORD

Isaiah encourages his people to seek the Lord and ask for his mercy – God whose thoughts are so far above their own.

Saint Paul tells the Philippians that Christ will be magnified in my body, whether by life or by death. And though Paul longs to be with Jesus in the next life, it is better that he remains with them.

In the Gospel, Jesus tells a parable about workers in a vineyard, emphasizing the generosity of the landowner to all who laboured.
